"ENGRAVED": GOD KNOWS YOU – INTIMATELY!

WE HAVE BEEN FORMED BY GOD'S HANDS OUT OF CLAY DUST

The Lord God formed man with His hands:

Genesis 2:7-8

- (7) And the LORD God <u>formed man of the dust of the ground</u>, and <u>breathed into his nostrils the breath of life</u>; and <u>man became a living</u> soul.
- (8) And the LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden; and there he put the man whom he had formed.

The word "formed" is this:

probably identical with H3334 (through the <u>squeezing</u> into shape); (compare H3331); to <u>mould</u> into a form; especially <u>as a potter</u>; figuratively to <u>determine</u> (that is, form a resolution): - X earthen, fashion, form, frame, make (-r), potter, purpose.

Isaiah 49:2

(2) And <u>he hath made my mouth like a sharp sword;</u> in the <u>shadow of his hand hath he hid me</u>, and made me a polished shaft; <u>in</u> <u>his quiver hath he hid me</u>;

Isaiah 45:4-9

- (4) For Jacob my servant's sake, and Israel mine elect, I <u>have even called thee by</u> <u>thy name</u>: <u>I have surnamed thee</u>, though thou hast not known me.
- (5) <u>I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me</u>: <u>I</u> <u>girded thee</u>, though thou hast not known me:
- (6) That they may know from the rising of the sun, and from the west, that **there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else**.
- (7) <u>I form the light</u>, and [I] <u>create darkness</u>: <u>I make peace</u>, and [I] <u>create</u> evil: I the LORD do all these things.
- (8) Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: let the earth open, and let them bring forth *salvation*, and let *righteousness* spring up together; *I the LORD have created it*.
- (9) Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? or thy work, He hath no hands?

EVERY SPARROW THAT FALLS IS NOT FORGOTTEN, NOR OCCURS, WITHOUT GOD'S AWARENESS... AND HIS WILL!

The Lord sees every sparrow fall to the ground [Edit: That is, LANDING, *OR* **DYING!**] and is aware of and wills when we are brought to Heaven, too, all the more than the sparrows. (Matthew 10:29; Luke 12:6-7)

Also, the Lord knows every hair on your head, AND numbers them (which change in number, moment to moment!) (Luke 12:7)

Luke 12:6-9

- (6) Are not five <u>sparrows</u> sold for two farthings, and <u>not one of them is</u> <u>forgotten before God?</u>
- (7) But **even the very hairs of your head are all numbered**. Fear not therefore: **ye are of more value than many sparrows**.
- (8) Also I say unto you, *Whosoever shall confess me* before men, *him shall the Son of man also confess* before the angels of God:
- (9) But <u>he that denieth me</u> before men <u>shall be denied</u> before the angels of God.

Matthew 10:28-33

- (28) And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather **fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell**.
- (29) Are not two <u>sparrows</u> sold for a farthing? and <u>one of them shall not</u> <u>fall on the ground</u> without your Father.
- (30) But the very hairs of your head are all numbered.

- (3) Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted with all my ways.
- (4) For there is not a word in my tongue, but, lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether.

WE ARE ALL "ENGRAVED" ON HIS PALMS:

Isaiah 49:15-16

- (15) Can a woman forget her sucking child, that she should not have compassion on the son of her womb? *yea, they may forget, yet Will I not forget thee*.
- (16) **Behold, I have graven thee upon the palms of** *my* **hands**; thy walls *are* continually before me.
